Some winter updates & reminders

If you're reading this e-mail we have your e-mail address! If you are reading this on our web-site contact us with your e-mail to get newsletters as they are sent out. Don't forget to keep your information current including your telephone contact information. We can only contact you if we have it! From time to time we can send out automated messages for emergencies or water main breaks.

Updates coming in the new year include utility billing changes.

In the new year you will begin receiving utility bills every 2 months rather than quarterly. Notices will come by mail and e-mail. To request e-mail bills give us a call. E-mail bills will help avoid issues from delayed mail which can sometimes be a problem. Especially if you have a leak or end up with late fees. Over the years we have had many request to bill more frequently our new billing software makes this possible.

Beginning March 1, 2022 we will no longer bill residents for garbage service. The service is still contracted by the Village, Waste Management will be billing the residents for service instead of us. Waste Management offers many services as a direct customer. By being direct you'll get automated calls regarding your service and holiday schedules, review your services and accounts on-line as well as make payments and be able to request special services like "At your door".

Christmas Tree Recycling

Waste Management will pick up Christmas trees 6' in length (or cut into 2 pieces under 6' in length) January 5, 2022 and January 12, 2022 at no additional fee, one tree per residence for existing WM customers.

Let's talk snow!

As a reminder all vehicles must be removed from Village streets when snow accumulation reaches 2 inches. The Village has 2 lots available for parking when the forecast calls for 2 inches of snow or more. Lot A is located on Adams Street next to the Library and Lot B is located on Jefferson Street north of the Malta Historical Society. Postal regulations also require residents to remove snow around mailboxes so delivery can take place. Thank you in advance for moving trash cans off the street as soon as possible to assist with snow removal efforts. If you have questions regarding snow removal give us a call at 815-825-2330 ext. 3

Property Maintenance

Electric Aggregation

The Village recently was notified that Eligo Energy is suspending our aggregation contract for 6 months. Participating customers do not need to do anything they will automatically be switched to ComEd. ComEd rates will be monitored and if Eligo can resume aggregation pricing they will. This is due to "Regulatory Events" not controllable by Eligo and suspension of the contract is permitted.
